

# TRAIL INCENTIVE PROGRAM

The purpose of this program is to promote and encourage the Montgomery Co. OHC members to log and report their trail miles

The Montgomery County OHC Treasurer, will purchase patches annually, as each individual member reports their miles. At the designated meeting, these patches will be presented to the members for their accumulated mileage.

To qualify, members must have their mileage forms completed and turned in to the Chapter Mileage Coordinator by Jan. 15. All OHC State mileage rules apply. An ADULT and YOUTH (under 18) award will be presented to the top mileage tallied for that category. The award will be either a \$50.00 check, or an OHC belt buckle. This award will be given in each category, at the winner's choice. The Adult award cannot be given to the same person more than once in a five year period. The Youth award cannot be given to the same person more than once in a two year period.

The Chapter Mileage Coordinator will keep all records, and submit those forms required by the OHC STATE MILEAGE CHAIRPERSON, BY January 31. It will be the responsibility of the Chapter Mileage Coordinator to keep a running total of mileage accumulated and those patches awarded from year to year. The Chapter Mileage Coordinator will order those patches needed and assure they are ready to be presented at the designated awards meeting.

The Chapter Mileage Coordinator will also keep track of all members reported miles, and those reports returned from the OHC State Mileage Chairperson.

## PATCHES TO BE AWARDED AND QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENT

200 MILE PATCH	MILES RIDDEN ANYWHERE
500 MILE PATCH	MILES RIDDEN ANYWHERE
CHEVRON/BAR (Silver)	1,000 MILES ACCUMULATED, RIDDEN ANYWERE
CHEVRON/BAR (Gold)	5,000 MILES ACCUMULATED, RIDDEN ANYWHERE
1,000 MILE OHIO PARKS & FORESTS	ONLY FOR MILES RIDDEN IN OHIO PARKS & FORESTS
5,000 MILE OHIO PARKS & FORESTS	ONLY FOR MILES RIDDEN IN OHIO PARKS & FORESTS

## GUIDELINES

1. The chapter will purchase patches/chevrons/bars, which will reflect the total accumulated mileage the person is eligible for.
2. IE: In 1998 you rode 250 miles, you will receive a 200-mile patch, then in 1999 you ride 345 miles, giving you an accumulation of 595 miles you will receive a 500-mile patch. In 2000 you ride 750 miles, this will qualify you for a 1,000-mile chevron/bar since your total accumulated mileage is 1345. (Once you have received a 200 or 500 mile patch you will not be eligible for them again) If in this three-year period you accomplished 1,000 miles in OHIO PARKS & FORESTS you would also receive your 1,000-mile OHIO PARKS & FORREST patch.
3. Any member wishing to purchase additional patches/chevrons/bars may order them from the STATE MILEAGE CHAIRPERSON.
